Dear NENAEA Member:

One, possibly two, of your employees who have an immediate family member who is currently a senior in high school and/or is enrolled in a college could help defray the student's college expenses with a \$2,000 scholarship.

The Nelson A. Demers, George F. White and Frank Standley Scholarships for the 2010-2011 school year will be awarded in October 2010, at the NENAEA Fall Conference. The Scholarship Committee is requesting your assistance in encouraging eligible employees of your newspaper to apply. There will be three \$2,000 scholarships awarded.

The scholarships are open to eligible candidates who have an immediate family member — parent, stepparent, aunt, uncle, sibling, grandparent, spouse — currently employed at the NENAEA member newspaper. Retired member families are also eligible. There are no restrictions regarding the applicant's major.

The Scholarship Committee selects winners based on specific qualifications. The attached form, which candidates are required to complete, details the qualifications. There are certain documents also required. Applicants who do not provide all the information and documents will not be considered.

Applications must be postmarked no later than July 31, 2010.
