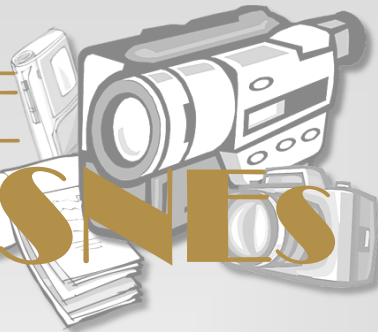

### **Judith Vance Weld Brown Spirit of Journalism Award**

This is the 19th year that the New England Society of News Editors Board of Governors will present the **Judith Vance Weld Brown Spirit of Journalism Award**, which recognizes the accomplishments of an outstanding woman in journalism. The honoree will exemplify the pioneering spirit of the late Judy Brown, longtime publisher and editor of the New Britain Herald and NESNE's first female president. Brown blazed trails for women in a difficult world, was passionate in her commitment to presenting local news, had a fierce determination to defend the public's right to know, and possessed a generosity of spirit that was especially evident in her nurturing of young reporters.

**NESNE invites your nomination of a colleague who possesses similar qualities and has demonstrated excellence as a journalist.** The award is open to women with roots in New England journalism and at least five year's experience. Please submit a letter detailing the nominee's accomplishments and telling why you believe she exemplifies the spirit and qualities of Judy Brown. Please do not submit work samples.

### **Master Photographer**

Honoring a photographer with a career of 7+ years, with a majority of work in New England and currently working at a New England news organization – broadcast, print or online. One award will be presented to a photographer at a *daily* news organization and one will be presented to a photographer at who works for a *non-daily* news

### **Master Reporter**

Honoring a reporter with a career of 7+ years, with a majority of work in New England and currently working at a New England news organization – broadcast, print or online. One award will be presented to a reporter at a *daily* news organization and one will be presented to a reporter at who works for a *non-daily* news product.

### **Newsroom Rising Star**

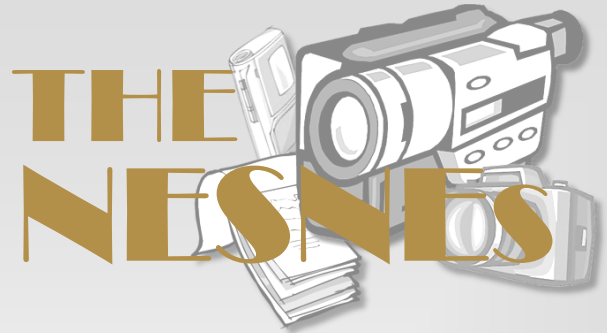
Honoring a newspaper journalist with a career of five or fewer years, who currently works on a New England newspaper.

# ENTRY FORM

**CATEGORIES:** Master Photographer, Master Reporter, Newsroom Rising Star and the Judith Vance Weld Brown Spirit of Journalism Award. All categories have an entry fee.

**DEADLINE:** March 28, 2019

**ENTRY FEE:** \$39 per nomination

**SUBMIT A NOMINATION!** All nominees must be full or part-time staffers. Each New England news organization is allowed multiple entries per category. Nominations should be accompanied by a brief letter of recommendation from the editor, stating the candidate's qualifications and professional background. Also include a portfolio of examples of the journalist's work over the course of his or her career. Backup material, such as tearsheets, photocopies of stories, web-links and PDFs may be submitted—excluding Judith Vance Weld Brown nomination.

Judges will place emphasis on the scope and quality of the nominee's work. For the "Rising Star" category, the judges may also consider the nominee's potential to do significant journalism in the future, based on his or her previous work.
