College RISING STAR AWARD – Honors an *undergrad* who is already distinguishing her or himself as a standout in the newsroom. Nominees may be reporters, editors, copy editors or digital journalists.

NESNE journalism award qualifications:

- 1. Must be a resident of New England.
- 2. Must be a college student study journalism or a related field in school.
- 3. Must have a GPA of 3.0 or above.
- 4. Must demonstrate a serious interest in a career in journalism by sending the following materials: Cover letter, transcript, resume or biography, letter of recommendation, AND a body of published work in a school news publication, general circulation newspaper, or a similar publication AND/OR a body of work prepared for a journalism class
