**TOP JOURNALIST** – A *college senior* who epitomized the best of the craft over his or her college journalism career. Nominees may be reporters, editors, copy editors or digital journalists.

**College RISING STAR AWARD** – Honors an *undergrad* who is already distinguishing her or himself as a standout in the newsroom. Nominees may be reporters, editors, copy editors or digital journalists.

### NESNE journalism award qualifications:

1. Must be a resident of New England.
2. Must be a college student study journalism or a related field in school.
3. Must have a GPA of 3.0 or above.
4. Must demonstrate a serious interest in a career in journalism by sending the following materials: Cover letter, transcript, resume or biography, letter of recommendation, **AND** a body of published work in a school news publication, general circulation newspaper, or a similar publication **AND/OR** a body of work prepared for a journalism class
